HUNTER DIVISIONS

Hunter Divisions to be judged on performance, soundness, manners, and way of going. Courses to simulate obstacles found in the hunt field: brush, walls, post and rails, gates, and flowers. Divisions will consist of 3 classes over fences and 1 class under saddle (exception walk/trot hunter).

LEAD LINE

Class 0 | Entry Fee \$5 | No Additional Fees

WALK TROT HUNTER

Class 1-2 | Entry Fee \$20/class

Riders to show at the walk and trot under saddle only.

18" HUNTER DIVISION

Class 3-6 | Entry Fee \$95/Division, \$25/Class

The 18" Hunter Division is open to all horses and riders. Fences not to exceed 18" in height. MHJA Recognized

2'0" SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER DIVISION

Class 7-10 | Entry Fee \$95/Division, \$25/Class

The 2'0" Short Stirrup Hunter Division is open to junior riders. Fences not to exceed 2'0" in height. MHJA Recognized

2'0" LONG STIRRUP HUNTER DIVISION

Class 11-14 | Entry Fee \$95/Division, \$25/Class

The 2'0" Long Stirrup Hunter Division is open to adult amateur riders. Fences not to exceed 2'0" in height. MHJA Recognized

2'3" OPEN HUNTER DIVISION

Class 15-18 | Entry Fee \$95/Division, \$25/Class

The 2'3" Hunter Division is open to all horses and riders. Fences not to exceed 2'3" in height. MHJA Recognized

2'6" OPEN HUNTER DIVISION

Class 19-22 | Entry Fee \$95/Division, \$25/Class

The 2'6" Hunter Division is open to all horses and riders. Fences not to exceed 2'6" in height. MHJA Recognized

3'0" OPEN HUNTER DIVISION

Class 23-26 | Entry Fee \$95/Division, \$25/Class

The 3'0" Hunter Division is open to all horses and riders. Fences not to exceed 3'0" in height. MHJA Recognized

3'3" OPEN HUNTER DIVISION

Class 27-30 | Entry Fee \$95/Division, \$25/Class

The 3'3" Hunter Division is open to all horses and riders. Fences not to exceed 3'3" in height. MHJA Recognized

EQUITATION DIVISIONS

Equitation Divisions to be judged on rider's seat, hands, guidance and control of mount. Division will consist of one class on the flat, one class over fences, and one medal class over fences.

The Equitation Medal Class will be judged with the same specifications as the over fence class. After all horses have completed the course, the top four riders will be brought back to test at the judge's discretion.

2'3" JUNIOR/ADULT AMATEUR BRONZE EQUITATION DIVISION

Class 31-33 | Entry Fee \$70/Division, \$25/Class

The Junior/Adult Amateur Bronze Equitation Division is open to junior and amateur riders. Fences not to exceed 2'3" in height.

2'6" JUNIOR/ADULT AMATEUR SILVER EQUITATION DIVISION

Class 34-36 | Entry Fee \$70/Division, \$25/Class

The Junior/Adult Amateur Bronze Equitation Division is open to junior and amateur riders. Fences not to exceed 2'6" in height.

MHJA Recognized

3'0" OPEN GOLD EQUITATION DIVISION

Class 37-39 | Entry Fee \$70/Division, \$25/Class

The Open Equitation Division is open to all riders. Fences not to exceed 3'0" in height. MHJA Recognized

JUMPER DIVISIONS

Jumper Divisions will consist of three classes over fences.

Ribbons awarded through sixth place. The final round in each division will be a classic round and prizes will be distributed.

Jumper classes are run over a course of eight to ten fences.

Obstacles may include verticals, oxers, and combinations. Jumper fences are generally composed of rails, gates, and planks and may have brightly colored rails and planks in addition to flowers and decorations.

Class 51 | Classic | Entry Fee \$30

Class scored according to USEF Table II Section 2(b). Timed first Jump Off. Fences not to exceed .90m.

Class scored according to USEF Table II Section 2(b). Fences not to exceed 1.0m.

Class 54 | Classic | Entry Fee \$30

Class scored according to USEF Table II Section 2(b). Timed first Jump Off. Fences not to exceed 1.0m.

Class scored according to USEF Table II Section 2(a). Timed first Jump Off. Fences not to exceed 1.20m.

Specifications

Heights:

The following fence dimensions are approximate equivalents in metric and English units:

0.60 m = Fences 2'0" in height

0.70 m = Fences 2'3" in height

0.80 m = Fences 2'7" in height

0.90 m = Fences 2'11" in height

1.00 m = Fences 3'3" in height

1.10 m = Fences 3'7" in height

1.20 m = Fences 3'11" in height

Width:

a. All courses require a minimum of three obstacles in which the spread exceeds the height by 5 cm (2") up to 15 cm (6").

b. Triple Bars may be up to 30 cm (12") wider than the height listed.

Format:

Optimum Time in First Round (Table IV Sec. 1)-The first round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. In the case of equality of faults, ties will be broken on the following basis: an "Optimum Time" (determined as 4 seconds less than the Time Allowed for the course; which is 350 meters per minute) will be posted on the course plan; the horse with the time on course closest to this Optimum Time (over or under) will prevail in the tie, next closest next, etc.

Table II, Sec. 2 (b)-The first round and first jump-off, if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. If a competitor has gone clean in the first round, the competitor will, without leaving the ring, upon an audible signal, commence the designated jump-off course. A competitor with a clear round may dismount, and with assistance if necessary, adjust tack and/or equipment; however, upon the audible signal to begin his/her round, the competitor is responsible to adhering to the 45 seconds rule as per JP134.3. A competitor who leaves the arena after a clear round (before or after the tone) will be considered to have retired from the jump-off. If there are no clean rounds and a tie exists for first place, there will be one jump-off in which time will decide in the event of equality of faults. It is recommended that no more than ten numbered obstacles be included in the first round when the class is scored under this table.

Faults Converted to Time (Table III)- Faults incurred when jumping an obstacle, for knocking down a boundary flag or for putting one or more feet in the water are penalized by adding four seconds for each occurrence. A time limit of 120 seconds will be automatically applied. Seconds added due to jumping faults do not count towards the 120 or 180 second time limit determination. The first disobedience is penalized automatically by the extra time taken.

Table II, Sec 2(a)- The first round and first jump-off are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the time allowed. In the event of equality of faults after the first round, there will be one jump- off for first place only in which time will decide in the event of equality of faults. Jump-off happens at the completion of all entries in the first round.

Additional Information

Open Schooling: Open schooling on Friday June 3rd from 3PM – 7PM for a \$25 fee. Open Schooling on the day of the show from 6AM – 7:15AM free of charge. On Saturday and Sunday the ring will be cleared for preparations at 7:15 sharp. Only 10 horses will be allowed in the arena at any one time. Please call jumps audibly and ride with safety as the highest priority. The jumps will be set at .70m (2'3") but may be adjusted as necessary. Please return the jumps to .70m when finished raising or lowering.

Directions: From Bozeman, travel west on Main Street. Turn South on Cottonwood Rd. From Four Corners, travel east on Huffine. Turn South on Cottonwood Road. Drive for 4 miles South on Cottonwood Rd. Turn right on Johnson Road. Travel 0.6 miles and turn left on VanDyke Rd. There is a green Tri-H sign. Travel 0.4 miles and turn left into the Tri-H driveway. VanDyke Rd. is a private road. Please drive 15 MPH. Park by the show barn on the right as you approach the main barn.

Stabling: Stabling is available on a first come first serve basis at Tri-H for \$30/night. One bag of shavings will be provided. There is a \$50 charge for any stalls that have not been fully stripped at the end of the period of use.

Camping: RV hookups with electricity are available at Tri-H for \$30/night.

Entries: Pre-entries are due by Friday May 26th. Due to the number of classes and tight schedule **pre-entries are strongly encouraged!** Post entries will be accepted the day of the show with an added fee of \$25.
